WE DON'T SEEM TO SEE YOUR SIGNATURE ON OUR PETITION

Sorry, we must have missed you.

During our fall petition campaign, "Families for St. Paul's" volunteers reached out to supporters at the St. Paul's soccer fields, at the *very wet* Homecoming football game, at our community presentation in October, during our Election Day endeavor, outside the Golden Goose Gala in November, and through individual efforts. While our "Families" group has shared the 1,000 signatures collected last fall with Senator Kemp Hannon, we believe that continuing to document support for the Committee to Save St. Paul's mixed use solution will strengthen our position.

Since you have in some way indicated that you are supportive of the Committee to Save St. Paul's, we invite you to *virtually* sign our petition by replying to this email and requesting that your name be added to the "Petition to Save St. Paul's for Community Use." Following is the petition:

We, the undersigned, support the mission of The Committee to Save St. Paul's to find a reasonable and affordable solution to save the historic St. Paul's building (circa 1879) and to keep it under public control for public use. The historic St. Paul's main building and surrounding acres were purchased in 1993 from the Episcopal Diocese of Long Island for use by the residents of the Village. I understand that this goal may involve some public expense; therefore, I do not oppose some form of mixed public-private use to help offset the operating costs associated with restoration and maintenance of the Main Building; however, the structure should remain under the ownership of the Village of Garden City and its residents. I believe that the primary purpose for the St. Paul's School building should be for community use, first and foremost, not for condominium development.
