IMPORTANT VOTER INFORMATION

In line with all village and fire district elections, voters are required to be registered in Nassau County to be eligible to vote.

- If you want to vote in the St. Paul's bond referendum this Wednesday and you are sure you are **NOT registered** at **this time**, you can **go as soon as possible to the Board of Elections, 240 Old Country Road, Mineola, during business hours and register.**
- **Everyone should vote regardless of whether they think they're registered or not.** Someone may have registered 40 years ago and have forgotten. Also, and **most importantly, if the voting inspector tells you that you are not registered and cannot vote, please advise the inspector that YOU WANT TO VOTE BY AFFIDAVIT BALLOT**, and the voting inspector can confirm later whether you are eligible to vote. This could be crucial if those who want to preserve St. Paul's need to challenge the vote for any reason.
